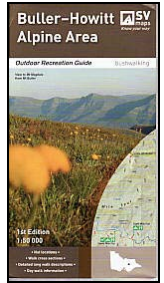

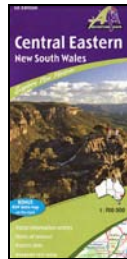

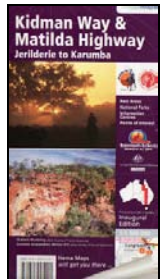

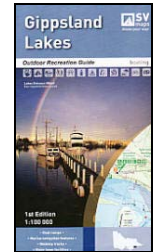

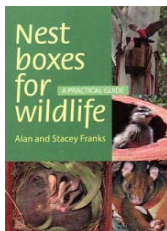

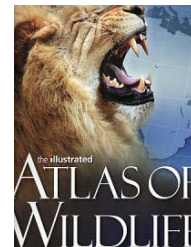

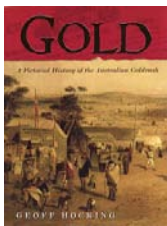

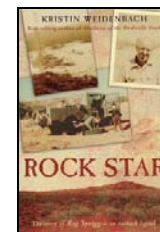

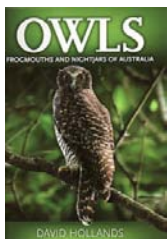

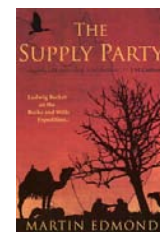


The Supply Party
