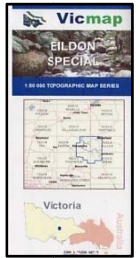

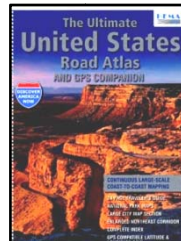

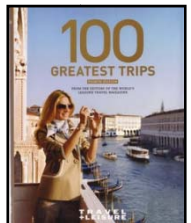

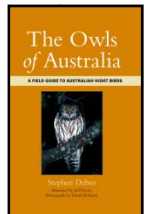

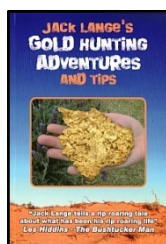

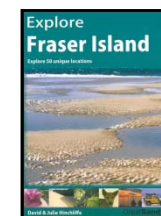

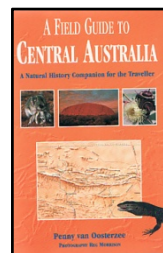


A Field Guide to Central Australia

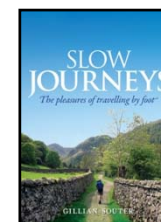
