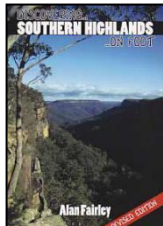

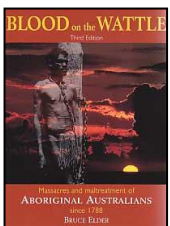

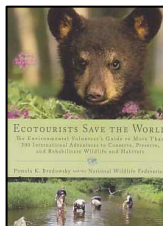

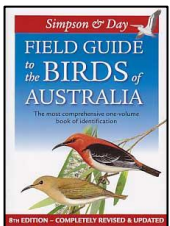

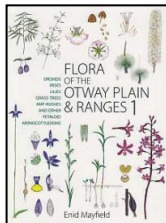


### Flora of the Otway Plain & Ranges 1

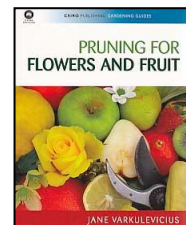

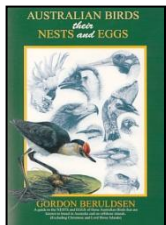


### Australian Birds their Nests and Eggs
