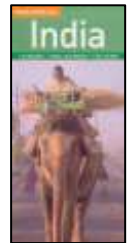

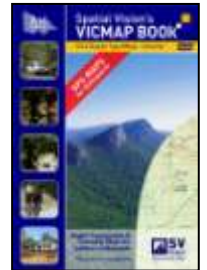

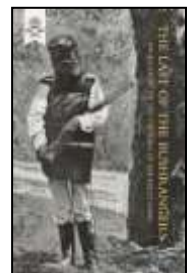
The Last of the Bushrangers

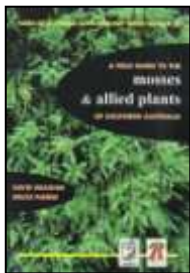

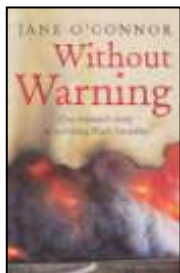


Without Warning

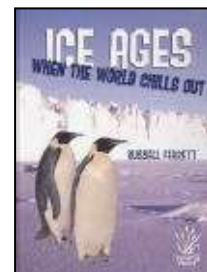


Ice Ages - When the World Chills Out

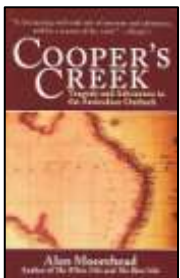

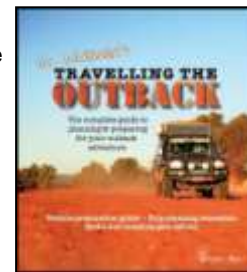
