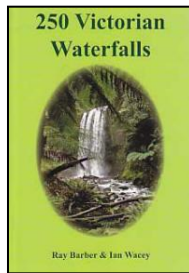

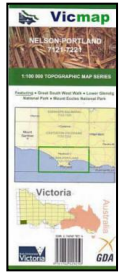
250 Victorian Waterfalls by Ray Barber & Ian Wacey

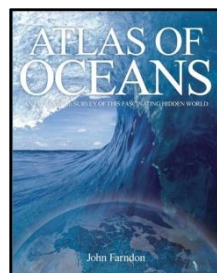

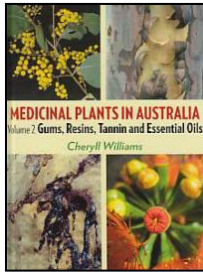
