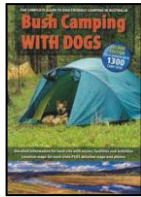


Bicycle Maps of Victoria

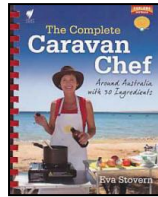

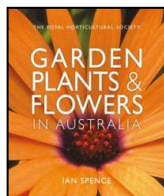

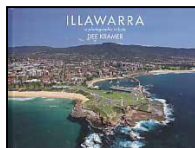

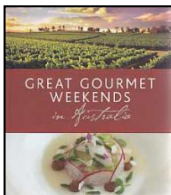

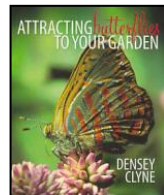
