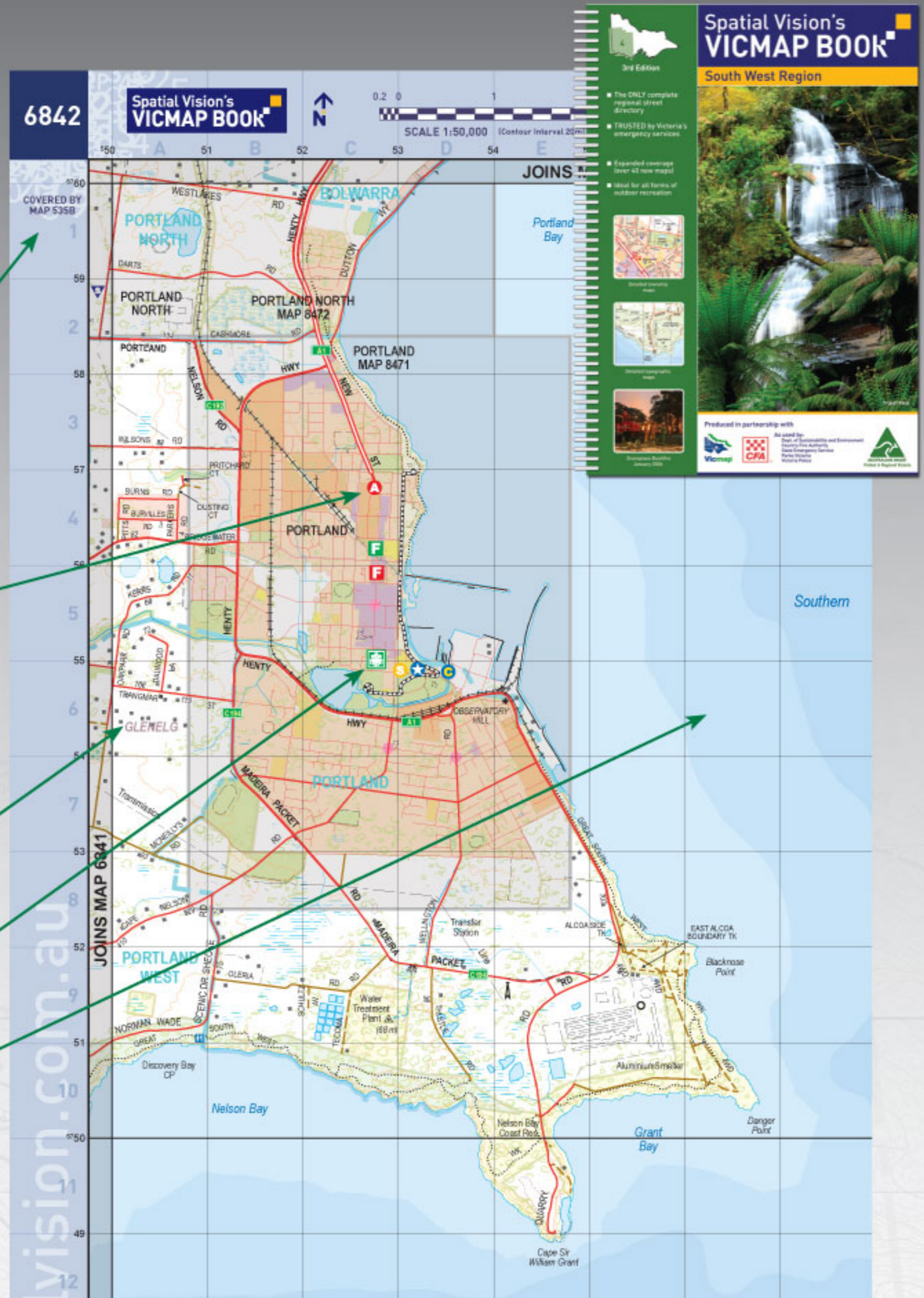


WHAT'S NEW IN EDITION 3?

Pick up a South West Edition 3 Vicmap Book and compared to Edition 2 you will find:

- **43 new maps** including:
 - ☑ 9 – 1:100,000 maps (overlapping with the North West book)
 - ☑ 11 – 1:50,000 maps
 - ☑ 23 – 1:20,000 town maps
- Reference on 1:50,000 maps to the corresponding 1:100,000 map number covering that area through the "COVERED BY MAP ..." text below the map number.
- Updated School, Hospital, Emergency Service, and Aged Care locations
- Location of Prisons and Law Courts
- Location of Vineyards, Wineries, Cellar Doors and Breweries
- Better **State Forest** names
- Updated building points with these now classified as a House, Building or Shed
- **Neighbourhood Safer Places** - Places of Last Resort - correct at the time of printing
- **Bathymetry** (depicting approximate sea depths) along Victoria's coastline
- Major and Minor **Rest Areas** on freeways
- **Emergency Markers** used in verifying the location of a 000 emergency phone call
- Authoritative data along border with South Australia
- Clearer depiction on 1:100,000 maps of areas covered by 1:50,000 enlargements
- Improvements in the look and usability of the maps through:
 - ☑ Emergency Service symbols on 1:100,000 maps, where there is a town enlargement, are placed all in a row rather than in their correct location.
 - ☑ Index of Roads box is used on town maps in areas where there is not enough space to include every road name. This provides a cross reference to the actual location of the road with the road name.
